The Bills face a critical draft to fill some significant needs on both sides of the ball. Despite a major move to trade for a legit WR1 in DJ Moore, sending the Bills 2nd round pick in this draft to Chicago, the offense could still use one more receiver with speed and size to add to the roster to both make an immediate impact, and provide some long term stability with a cost controlled WR on a rookie contract. Other than some depth on the o-line, the offense seems close to be complete. On the flip side, as the Bills transition from McDermott's Heavy Zone, bend don't break, 4-2-5 D, to Jim Leonhard's aggressive 3-4/ Hybrid scheme, there are a multiple of positions needing upgrades and depth. That starts with the front 7, especially ILB, NT and Edge. While the draft has some quality, the premium options will dry up quickly and this mock attempts to optimize the value, as it tries to address each of the critical needs.

The Bills have invested heavily in Edge over the Beane era, but have not truly hit on finding that game changing difference maker. One thought, is swing for the fence with a potentially more explosive pass rush specialist. The two prospects likely to be available at 26, who seem to fit that dynamic potential, are Cashius Howell and Malachi Lawrence. Both have an explosive first step and elite bend, and flash the kind of explosive playmaker Beane has been searching for. However, both come with significant risk given their size, and production vs the run. While they could very well boost the pass rush production early, as passing down rush specialists, they may never grow beyond that role. Maybe that's enough, but for a team that was 28th in the NFL in rushing yards allowed per game with 136.2, 30th in Yards per rush (5.1), and 9th in giving up the most chunk rush plays of 20 yards with 13 and another 7 over 40 yards. They also gave up the 2nd most rushing TDs in the league with 24. It's sexy to think about adding a dynamic pass rusher, but the bigger problem for the Bills defense, is the inability to stop the run in a league cycle back to rush heavy offensive attacks again. They do still need to vastly improve the pass rush, to help them get off the field on 3rd down, another statistic in the Bills defensive futility as they ranked near the bottom in being able to get off the field. The one prospect that would be great value at 26 who not only offers solid run defense metrics, and the ability to set the edge, but also has long term pass rush potential given his explosive metrics and testing, and '24 production when he was freer to attack than he was in '25 is TJ Parker. One key measurable for Edges and LBs is their speed score. Parker's 56.2 was the highest score of any of my top 100 front seven prospects that ran 40s.

Parker is a bull with violent hands and loves to attack the edge, transitioning speed to power. He is stout at the point of attack, shedding blocks and setting the edge with authority. He has a punch that jolts Tackles and TEs, and collapses the pocket while maintaining gap integrity. He reminds me of a younger Bradley Chubb, who he can learn from, as he builds his pass rush tool bag and gains even more strength and bulk in an NFL system. His combine numbers speak to a prospect that has potential as an impact explosive playmaker, maybe even beyond his college production. Especially his 10 yard 1.61 split and 34" vertical. Parker also offers value the others do not have that will see him get on the field earlier and in more roles. He has the ability to slip inside to 5 tech or 4i on passing downs, where he showed the ability to shoot the gap, and win with more than just power as an insider rusher. "Consistently and with ease, Parker is able to explode at the snap, surprising even the swiftest tackles while infusing a violent and disruptive display of power to his game" Draft Bible The Bills can use some more violence on their D.

While this draft dries up in a hurry in the 2nd round at most positions, WR likely will offer some intriguing options for the Bills at pick 91. I have been higher than most on Ja'Kobi Lane from USC. Saw him live early this season, and have been a fan ever since. But Lance offers a little more potential upside as a multi-faceted weapon given his size, explosive speed, and great hands. He will need to prove he can do it against better secondaries than he saw at ND State, and he needs to continue to refine and improve his route tree, but physical traits and production, even at the FCS level, are rare. Dontay Corleone "The Godfather" (DT, Cincinnati) is a massive 6'1", 340-lb nose tackle prospect with elite density, low pad level, violent hands, and surprising short-area quickness for his size. Career stats include 123 tackles, 17 TFL, and 9.5 sacks over four seasons, highlighted by a strong 2022 (44 tackles, 5.5 TFL, 3 sacks) before injuries limited 2025 production to 14 tackles in 10 games. Scouts praise his anchor against doubles, play strength, and high-motor run-stuffing ability, though medical flags (blood clots, ankle issues) and limited pass-rush variety cap his ceiling as a 4th-round value. He'd fit perfectly as a space-eating O/1-tech to clog A-gaps, free up edge rushers and LBs, and provide immediate rotational depth on early downs.

Fitting the Bills: Deep Edge Class comes at right time for Buffalo

The 2026 Class is lacking in true Blue Chip talent at the top of the draft and the second and third tiers blend in a hurry. One possible position group exception is Edge. At the top of the class, David Bailey, Arvell Reese and Ruben Bain have a chance to be impact contributors early in their careers and will likely fly off the board in the top 10-12 picks. After that, there is a steep drop, but quality will be found through the end of round 1 and into day 2.

The Buffalo Bills face a critical decision with the 26th pick in the 2026 NFL Draft. Their new defensive scheme under coordinator Jim Leonhard demands edge rushers who blend speed, power, and smart gap control. The Bills have tried to find a high end impact Edge both through the draft, and in free Agency under Beane, but have failed to truly find the answer. This year, Beane may take one more swing in the first round, especially given the fact the Bills do not currently have a 2nd rounder, and all of those tier 2 or 3 guys may be gone before they get to pick again at the bottom of round 3.

After the top 3, Keldrick Faulk is likely to hear his name in the top half of the first. That leaves a handful of intriguing options for the Bills that will either drop to them or will fall in striking range of pick 26. In order of PFWR rankings, (22) T.J. Parker, (25) Akheem Mesidor, (30) Zion Young and (35) Cashius Howell are all strong possibilities for the Bills. Among those prospects, T.J. Parker from Clemson stands out as the best possible fit for the Bills' needs and new system.

Why T.J. Parker could be the answer for Buffalo.

Parker possesses the size, length and athleticism to be a future foundational piece of the Bills new defense. Despite a drop in production this past season, Parker's decline reflects a shift in Clemson's defensive philosophy rather than a fall in his talent or potential.

This take was backed by NFL scouts as quoted in Bob McGinn's annual insider series, "They changed defensive coordinators and he didn't have the freedom to go rush and it probably impacted his year," "He didn't have great production this year but I liked his tape, he's got quickness and power. Plays with a lot of energy. He's physical. He's an end-of-the-first-round type." Clemson switched from an aggressive, attacking defense to a more conservative, gap-control approach aimed at limiting big plays. This change impacted Parker's sack and tackle-for-loss totals, as the defense prioritized containment over constant pressure. Parker's skill set, however, remains elite.

He shares many traits with former Clemson star and current NFL standout Bradley Chubb: a blend of speed and power, an attacking style with a tight arc to the quarterback, and the ability to win one-on-one battles. Before the scheme change, Parker was projected as a top-10 pick. He recorded 11 sacks, 6 forced fumbles, and 19.5 TFL. The numbers when he was turned loose speak more to his potential than his 5 sack 9.5 TFL numbers this past season when his responsibilities changed.

Parker proved Senior Bowl week, he does indeed possess that game wrecking ability when unleashed. His athletic testing also supports the belief in a high ceiling, turning in 4.68 40 with a 1.61 10 yard split, and a RAS total of 9.93. In fact, those testing numbers compare almost identically with recent Bills FA pick up, Bradley Chubb. Like Chubb, Parker attacks the edge with power and violent hands. He runs a tight arc, and controls the edge, keeping QBs penned in, and guarding against outside runs.

While Parker relies heavily on his long armed bull rush to overpower and overwhelm, he has added an effective push/pull counter attack, but still needs to add more clubs to his bag. His relentless bulldozing motor is more old school Terminator 1 to the T2, and he does sometimes get miss tackles when he needs to quickly change direction in pursuit.

Parker has the flexibility to rush from either OLB position, or drop inside to 4i. That being said, he is at his best when spread out wide and allowed to rush coming down the runway. That added speed even further converts to power, and can become a disruptive force. That and his 3 down ability, will help him jump right into the rotation while he simultaneous apprentices under Chubb.

The Bills were at the bottom of the league vs the run last season and a large part of that was due to poor gap discipline. Adding a young Edge, that not only can add to the pressure rate, but also can be relied on to set the edge and demonstrate strong gap discipline, would be the ideal fit to start the draft for the Bills.

Cashius Howell has been a popular projection to the Bills in recent mocks. There is no denying his explosive production this past year, but his 30.25" arms, and small frame will not boost the run defense, making him a situational pass rush specialist at best early in his career. Getting to the QB is obviously a premium, but at what cost are those extra 2 or 3 sacks in the year, when teams will just load up and attack his side with power. Those measurables are a major outlier for an impact edge in the NFL, and finding someone who has almost the same burst and a season with equal production with prototype size and elite power makes it a slam dunk. Of course, if Parker is off the board, then Howell becomes a sound option.

Both Parker and Howell have elite athletic profiles, but only Parker has a true prototypical NFL frame. Durability matters, and that frame will help Parker endure 17 regular season games plus up to 4 postseason contests.

Diving into the production, Howell no doubt had an elite season, but old Aaron Maybin flashbacks of one year wonders with elite athletic profiles combined with an undersized frame does scare me. Parker's '24 season was just as elite as Howell's '25, plus he has an elite knack for forcing fumbles, which is an indication he is around the ball and hits with impact.

Top Edge Rusher Prospects for the 2026 NFL Draft

1. David Bailey – Texas Tech

Grade: 9.27 PFWR Rank: 3

Profile: Bailey combines size (6'3, 251 lbs) with speed (4.50 40-yard dash) and power. His quick first step and relentless motor make him a constant threat off the edge. His 9.68 agility score shows his ability to bend around tackles. Bailey's game fits a more attacking style but can adapt to gap control.

2. Arvell Reese – Ohio State

Grade: 9.00 PFWR Rank: 5

Profile: Reese is a versatile edge rusher with a 4.53 40-yard dash and solid strength. Ohio State's defense allowed him to showcase both pass rush and run defense skills. His 7.80 power score and 8.40 agility make him a balanced player who can fit multiple schemes.

3. Rueben Bain Jr. – Miami

Grade: 8.68 PFWR Rank: 7

Profile: Bain Jr. is a bigger edge at 6'2, 263 lbs with a 4.82 40-yard dash. His strength and length help him control the line of scrimmage. He's less explosive but excels in setting the edge and disrupting run plays, which aligns with Leonhard's philosophy.

4. Keldric Faulk – Auburn

Grade: 8.15 PFWR Rank: 21

Profile: Faulk's 6'5, 276 lbs frame and 4.75 40-yard dash make him a powerful edge presence. His 9.05 power score is among the best in the class. Faulk's ability to anchor against the run and rush the passer fits a gap-control scheme well.

5. T.J. Parker – Clemson

Grade: 8.14 PFWR Rank: 22

Profile: Parker's 6'3, 263 lbs frame and 4.68 40-yard dash show his rare blend of speed and power. His 8.81 burst and 9.39 agility scores highlight his quickness and bend. Despite the dip in production, his skill set matches Buffalo's defensive needs perfectly.

6. Akheem Mesidor – Miami

Grade: 7.99 PFWR Rank: 25

Profile: Mesidor is a strong, athletic edge with a 4.85 40-yard dash. His ability to rush the passer and hold the edge in run defense makes him a promising prospect, especially if the Bills look for depth later in the draft.

7. Zion Young – Missouri

Grade: 7.90 PFWR Rank: 30

Profile: Heavy-handed edge; strong run defender. Flag: legal issues/ Lacks elite lateral bend.

8. Gabe Jacas - Illinois

Grade: 7.87 PFWR Rank: 32

Profile: Bull-rush specialist; elite play strength. Flag: Average lateral agility. Surprisingly struggles vs run despite size. His ability to play multiple roles on the edge makes him a flexible option.

9. Cashius Howell - Texas A&M

Grade: 7.81 PFWR Rank: 35

Profile: An explosive, undersized pass rush specialist. Howell may slip in end of first round due to his elite explosive profile and college production (11.5 sacks and 14 TFL in '25) His short arms (30.25") and light frame may make him a liability vs the run, and may limit his production on Sunday's vs Saturday.

Fitting the Bills: Inside Linebackers for the 2026 NFL Draft

The Buffalo Bills enter the 2026 offseason with a clear mandate to bolster their defense under new coordinator Jim Leonhard, whose scheme emphasizes an attacking, aggressive philosophy. Leonhard, drawing from his time as a player and coach in systems like Wisconsin's and Denver's under Sean Payton, favors a multiple-front defense that prioritizes disruption at the line of scrimmage, heavy blitz packages, and versatile second-level defenders. This approach demands inside linebackers (ILBs) who can diagnose plays quickly, flow sideline-to-sideline, drop into coverage against modern passing attacks, and rush the passer when called upon. Key traits in Leonhard's ILBs include high football IQ (often wearing the green dot for play-calling), explosive burst to close on ball carriers, reliable tackling in space, and the versatility to handle man/zone coverage or blitz from various alignments. With the Bills moving on from aging and oft injured Matt Milano and depth concerns lingering, the Bills need ILBs who can step in and make an immediate impact in this high-pressure system.

In this edition of "Fitting the Bills," we spotlight five ILB prospects available across Rounds 1-7 who align with Buffalo's needs. We've prioritized players projected to be on the board at pick 26 (Round 1) or later, focusing on two premier potential starters, one pure depth piece with special teams upside, and two sleeper steals. Each profile includes scouting notes, combine workouts, leadership details, and their projected fit and impact in Leonhard's defense.

Jake Golday, Cincinnati (Projected: Round 1, Pick 26)

Jake Golday is a prototypical modern ILB with the tools to anchor Leonhard's defense from Day 1. At 6'4" and 239 pounds, he combines length and instincts, earning a reputation as a green-dot communicator who quarterbackes the second level. His tape includes sideline-to-sideline range, physical run-stuffing ability, and fluidity in coverage—traits that earned him All-AAC honors and a Butkus Award finalist nod in 2025. He's a vocal leader, serving as team captain at Cincinnati, where he called defenses and mentored younger players.

Combine Workouts: Height: 6'4 3/8", Weight: 239 lbs, 40-Yard Dash: 4.62 seconds, Bench Press: 24 reps, Vertical Jump: 36 inches, Broad Jump: 10'2", 3-Cone Drill: 7.05 seconds, Short Shuttle: 4.25 seconds. His explosive metrics (RAS 9.73) underscore his freakish athleticism, with elite burst and agility that popped in drills.

Fit and Potential Impact: Golday's high IQ and versatility make him an ideal Mike linebacker in Leonhard's scheme, where he'd soon be wearing the green dot, blitz on third downs (he notched 6.5 sacks in 2025), and cover tight ends or backs in zone. As a potential three-down starter alongside Bernard, he could elevate Buffalo's run defense (ranked 18th in 2025) and projects to be a tackling machine. Leonhard will drool at his versatility with multiple snaps on tape at DE both in 2 and 3 point stands, MLB, and under backer on the strong side. His size and athleticism will add a dimension to the Bills backers that they simply do not and have not had since Tremaine Edmunds left. He would allow Bernard and Dorian Williams to play Weak Inside backer wear their lack of size would be less of a liability vs the run. No prospect, likely to be available to the Bills at pick 26 or later has a greater potential to transform their defense. Although pre-combine projections have him as a day 2 prospect, the secret is likely out and he will begin to climb expert draft boards as they catch up. PFWR has him ranked 15th overall and the 2nd highest LB after Sonny Styles.

C.J. Allen, Georgia (Projected: Late Round 1/Early Day 2)

C.J. Allen is a high-IQ linebacker with the instincts and leadership to thrive in an attacking scheme, making him a strong fit if available around pick 26 or via a slight trade-up. At 6'1" and 230 pounds, scouting notes praise his football smarts, timely pursuit, and ability to read offenses pre-snap, drawing from Georgia's championship pedigree. He recorded 85 tackles, 7 TFLs, and 2 INTs in 2025, showing polish against elite SEC competition. Allen served as a co-captain in 2025, organizing extra film sessions and leading by example in practice.

Combine Workouts: Height: 6'0 5/8", Weight: 230 lbs, 40-Yard Dash: 4.60 seconds, Bench Press: 22 reps, Vertical Jump: 34.5 inches, Broad Jump: 9'10", 3-Cone Drill: 7.12 seconds, Short Shuttle: 4.28 seconds. His solid testing (RAS 7.1) highlights reliable athleticism, with good short-area quickness evident in coverage drills.

Fit and Potential Impact: Allen's instinctive play and green-dot potential align perfectly with Leonhard's philosophy, where he'd excel as a Mike or Will, diagnosing runs and dropping into zone coverage. His leadership would stabilize the unit, potentially contributing 90+ tackles and play-calling duties as a Year 1 starter, providing a seamless transition if Milano misses time.

Jacob Rodriguez, Texas Tech (Projected: Day 2, Rounds 2-3)

Jacob Rodriguez is a high-motor, versatile ILB with elite instincts who could provide immediate depth and special teams value while developing into more. At 6'1" and 231 pounds, scouting notes emphasize his range, tackling efficiency (under 10% miss rate in 2025), and ability to contribute in sub-packages. He tallied 92 tackles and 5 TFLs for Texas Tech in 2025, showing growth in coverage. Rodriguez was a team captain in his senior year, known for his work ethic and rallying the defense during tough stretches.

Combine Workouts: Height: 6'0 7/8", Weight: 231 lbs, 40-Yard Dash: 4.57 seconds, Bench Press: 23 reps, Vertical Jump: 35 inches, Broad Jump: 10'0", 3-Cone Drill: 7.00 seconds, Short Shuttle: 4.20 seconds. Impressive agility metrics (RAS 9.52) stood out, making him fluid in pursuit and coverage simulations.

Fit and Potential Impact: In Leonhard's scheme, Rodriguez would rotate at Will, blitzing occasionally and covering in nickel sets, while his motor makes him a core special teamer on coverage units. He could add 40-60 tackles in Year 1, offering insurance against injuries and growing into a rotational staple. While Rodriguez is an intriguing prospect that fits the profile of Bills LBs in the McD era, my feeling is he may not fit what Leonhard's vision is quiet as well.

Anthony Hill Jr., Texas (Projected: Day 2, Rounds 2-3)

A rising star from the SEC, Anthony Hill Jr. brings star potential with his blend of speed and physicality. At 6'2" and 238 pounds, he's a heat-seeking missile against the run, with scouting notes praising his instinctive pursuit angles, gap-shooting burst, and ability to shed blocks. Hill tallied 98 tackles, 8 TFLs, and 4 sacks in 2025, showing polish in Texas' aggressive front. He wasn't a full-time captain but emerged as a vocal leader in the linebacker room, organizing film sessions and motivating during key games.

Combine Workouts: Height: 6'2", Weight: 238 lbs, 40-Yard Dash: 4.51 seconds, Bench Press: 22 reps, Vertical Jump: 37.5 inches, Broad Jump: 10'5", 3-Cone Drill: 6.95 seconds, Short Shuttle: 4.18 seconds. His testing mirrored top 2024 performers like Payton Wilson, with elite explosion that shone in position drills.

Fit and Potential Impact: Hill's twitchy athleticism fits Leonhard's attacking style, where he'd thrive as a Will linebacker blitzing off the edge or flowing to the ball in run support. His coverage chops (allowed under 7 yards per target in 2025) would bolster Buffalo's pass defense against RBs and TEs. As a Year 1 rotational starter with Pro Bowl upside, he could contribute 70+ tackles and force fumbles, providing insurance if injuries hit the unit again. Hill may be the best fit for the Bills after Golday given his size and versatility.

Jack Kelly, BYU (Projected: Day 2, Rounds 3-4)

Jack Kelly is a toolsy sleeper with steal potential, blending size and explosion for upside in an aggressive defense. At 6'2" and 240 pounds, scouting notes highlight his burst off the snap, sideline range, and improving pass-rush moves, with 78 tackles, 9 TFLs, and 4 sacks in 2025 at BYU. He emerged as a leader without formal captaincy, mentoring underclassmen and stepping up in key games.

Combine Workouts: Height: 6'2", Weight: 240 lbs, 40-Yard Dash: 4.57 seconds, Bench Press: 25 reps, Vertical Jump: 37 inches, Broad Jump: 10'4", 3-Cone Drill: 6.98 seconds, Short Shuttle: 4.22 seconds. Elite explosion (RAS 9.81) shone through, with top-tier jumps and agility that impressed in bag work and shuttles.

Fit and Potential Impact: Kelly's athletic profile fits Leonhard's blitz-heavy approach, where he'd disrupt as a rotational ILB or edge hybrid, adding pass-rush juice. As a sleeper, he could outperform his slot with 50-70 tackles and sacks, providing high-upside depth that evolves into a starter.

Kaleb Elarms-Orr, TCU (Projected: Day 3, Rounds 3-4)

Kaleb Elarms-Orr is an athletic sleeper with impressive testing numbers and upside in coverage-heavy roles, making him a potential steal on Day 3. At 6'2" and 234 pounds, scouting notes highlight his above-average athleticism, explosiveness, physicality, agility, tackling, and pass-rushing ability, though instincts need refinement. Transferring from California to TCU, he earned All-Big 12 honors in 2025 with 119 tackles, 57 solo, and 9 TFLs, plus Big 12 Co-Defensive Player of the Week recognition. While not a formal captain, he emerged as a leader in the linebacker room, stepping up in key games and contributing to team morale.

Combine Workouts: Height: 6'2", Weight: 234 lbs, Arm: 31 1/2", Hand: 9", 40-Yard Dash: 4.47 seconds, Vertical Jump: 36.5 inches, Broad Jump: 10'2", Short Shuttle: 4.41 seconds. His elite speed and explosion (RAS 9.71, athletic score 83—7th among LBs) stood out, with top rankings in 40 (2nd), vertical (2nd), broad (8th), and shuttle (8th), impressing in pursuit and coverage drills.

Fit and Potential Impact: Elarms-Orr's sideline-to-sideline range and twitch fit Leonhard's blitz packages and zone coverage demands, where he'd disrupt as a rotational Will or coverage specialist. As a sleeper, he could add 50-70 tackles, interceptions, and pass-rush production in sub-packages, evolving into a three-down contributor with his NFL-ready frame and closing speed.

Josiah Trotter, Missouri (Projected: Day 3, Rounds 4-5)

Josiah Trotter is a raw but intriguing sleeper with NFL bloodlines (son of Jeremiah Trotter Sr.) and physical tools that scream value late. At 6'2" and 240 pounds, scouting notes focus on his power, gap-filling ability, and developing instincts, tallying 68 tackles and 6 TFLs in 2025 at Missouri. He wasn't a captain but showed leadership through his on-field toughness and offseason preparation.

Combine Workouts: Height: 6'2", Weight: 240 lbs, 40-Yard Dash: 4.72 seconds, Bench Press: 24 reps, Vertical Jump: 35.5 inches, Broad Jump: 10'1", 3-Cone Drill: 7.15 seconds, Short Shuttle: 4.30 seconds. Solid testing (RAS 7.8) with good power metrics, holding up well in strength-based drills.

Fit and Potential Impact: Trotter's strength and motor suit Leonhard's run-stuffing demands, where he'd contribute in base packages and on special teams. As a steal, his development could yield 40+ tackles and rotational snaps, offering low-cost upside. For another day 3 option, keep an eye on TCU's Kaleb Elarms-Orr, whose 4.47 speed (RAS 9.71) and range could provide similar sleeper value in coverage-heavy roles. These ILB prospects offer a mix of immediate starters, developmental depth, and hidden gems to fortify the Bills' defense. Stay tuned for our next piece on nose tackles. Jimmy Rolder (Michigan, 6'2½", 238-240 lbs, ~4.68 40)

Rolder's instincts and run-game consistency shine despite limited starts (only 11 in college, but dominant in his final year with 73 tackles, 7 TFL, 2 sacks, and leadership traits). He plays low with violent hands to shock blocks, finds efficient paths to the ball, and finishes tackles with rare technique and wrap consistency, broken tackles are almost nonexistent on tape. Awareness in space and route recognition help in coverage, though pursuit speed and length are average, limiting wide tackles. In Leonhard's defense, he'd excel as a reliable box ILB for run fits and stack-shed, adding physicality on early downs while contributing heavily on special teams as a core-four gunner/tackler. Consensus rankings place him around 200-280 overall (e.g., ~202-218 in major boards, late Day 3/UDFA projection in many mocks), but Buffalo's reported top-30 official visit signals real interest, likely viewing him as undervalued with starter traits if he lands in the right system. PFWR Rank is 107
